



NETCo FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT – WOODLAND PARK, CO PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Beginning **April 26th, 2021** and closing on **May 17th, 2021 at 5:00 pm** the NE Teller County Fire Protection District (NETCo) will be accepting applications for the position of Part-Time Firefighter.

The minimum qualifications an applicant must meet at time of application are as follows:

- 21 years of age
- Possess a valid Colorado Driver's License
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- **Maintain current good standing employment as a full-time firefighter with another agency**
- Maintain certification and training requirements to include, but not limited to: Colorado EMT-B, Firefighter 1, S-130/190

The intent of the Part-Time Firefighter Program is to supplement current fire and emergency services staffing of full-time firefighters with paid part-time firefighters to meet District staffing goals. Part-time firefighters (PTFF) are at-will non-exempt employees.

COMPENSATION

- NETCo Fire will provide PTFFs Workers Compensation Insurance and Unemployment Compensation Insurance
- NETCo Fire will work closely with PTFFs to provide district familiarization, apparatus, and equipment training
- NETCo Fire will provide PTFFs monetary payment at the current Board approved rate of \$15.50/hour for hours worked
- PTFFs are not eligible for any paid time off (vacation/sick)
- NETCo Fire will provide PTFFs with uniforms and PPE (Note: Uniforms/PPE from your full-time department shall **not** be used)

EMPLOYEE EXPECTATIONS

Staffing/Coverage/Scheduling

- You will be required to sign up for available shifts via the online calendar
- It is a goal of the NETCo Fire District to include one part-time employee into the daily staffing every calendar day
- As a part-time employee, you are an important part of the emergency response service of NETCo Fire District
- If you sign up for a NETCo Shift you are expected to fulfill your obligation, apart from sickness or a family emergency

Competencies/Capabilities

- Maintain fire, medical, and emergency service competency and training at your full-time agency
- Make it a priority to become familiar with all NETCo equipment and apparatus
- Participate proficiently in calls for service; eagerly attend training opportunities
- Complete the part-time orientation training program

Relations

- Although you may be part of the NETCo community intermittently, you are still an important part of our department family and service delivery model. It's expected that you be a productive, positive, kind, and engaging member of our organization.
- As indicated in the Personnel Manual, either party may terminate this part-time employment relationship at any time without cause or notice
