• Deputy Chief Rial discussed part-time hours, call volume last month.

DEPUTY CHIEF'S REPORT:

- Deputy Chief Rial discussed training hours. Deputy Chief Rial discussed training to include size-up and initial company operations at a fire scene with the DFPC Burn Trailer. The crews are continuing to train with the burn tower. The surrounding fire departments have also been able to utilize the tower for training. The crews training for EMS consisted of animal incidents, geographical and environmental emergencies, and summative training.
- Deputy Chief Rial discussed upcoming events to include NETCo's 40th anniversary Open House, National Night Out and Touch a Truck. Deputy Chief Rial thanked Karen for all the work she has put in organizing the Open House.
- Deputy Chief Rial updated the BOD on the process being made on Lexipol policies. A Career Development policy was sent to the crews to review. Lexipol has changed their platform, so the crews are learning to navigate.
- Deputy Chief Rial updated the BOD on the status of the FP&S grant and the Forrest Service Capacity grant.
