The Position

Northeast Teller County FPD is seeking One (1) qualified individual to fill an immediate Firefighter/Paramedic or Firefighter/EMT position within the organization.

The successful candidate must be willing to work a 48/96 schedule, and be able to deploy locally, state-wide, and nationally to wildland and all-hazard incidents.

The District

Northeast Teller County Fire Protection District provides Fire Protection, EMS, Hazmat, and Rescue services to the City of Woodland Park, Colorado, and the surrounding area, covering approximately 87 square miles of beautiful Colorado landscapes and responding to more than 1500 calls per year. Our Fire District of over 12,000 people is located in the foothills of Colorado, approximately 30 minutes west of Colorado Springs.

The Organization

Northeast Teller County Fire Protection District currently consists of 15 Full-Time Firefighters (3 Captains, 3 Engineers, 9 Firefighters), 15 Part-Time Firefighters, 1 Emergency Vehicle Technician, 1 Office Manager /HR / Accounting Clerk, 1 Deputy Chief of Operations/Training, and 1 Fire Chief, governed by a 5-member Board of Directors. NETCO consists of 2 fire stations; Station 1 (Headquarters) located in Woodland Park, and Station 3 (Apparatus Staging – Un-staffed) located between Woodland Park and Divide, CO.

Application Process

All interested applicants **MUST** meet the following minimum qualifications.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18yrs. old and in good physical condition.
- Must have at least 1 year experience as a career paid firefighter or 2 years of volunteer firefighter experience.
- Possess a high school diploma or GED.
- Colorado driver's license 30 days after employment.
- Current Colorado State or IFSAC/ProBoard Firefighter I Certification.
- Current Colorado State or IFSAC/ProBoard Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations certification.
- Current Colorado or National Registry EMT-Basic certification.
- A current and valid CPAT certificate within 6 months of hire.
- Candidates must be able to acquire NWCG Firefighter Type 2 by passing course requirements and Work Capacity (arduous) test within 3 months of hire.
- NIMS ICS/IS 100,200,700,800.
- Must pass a pre-employment drug test, physical, and background check.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Current Colorado or National Registry Paramedic certification.
- Associate degree or higher in Fire Science or related field.
- Current Colorado State or IFSAC/ProBoard Firefighter II certification.
- Current Colorado State or IFSAC/ProBoard Hazardous Materials Technician certification.
- NWCG Firefighter Type 1 or higher.
- NIMS ICS 300 certification.

Those candidates meeting the minimum qualifications may complete and return an application packet to the District no later than **Monday, May 4, 2026 at 4pm MDST** in order to be considered for the open position. Testing process will begin the week of May 11, 2026 tentatively.

Application Packets Must Include:

- Completed district application.
- Resume with at least 3 professional references.
- Copies of all required certifications.
- Official DMV driving record dated within the last 30 days.
